Each family will be provided packages of provision for 3 month period.

Impact:

Behavioral change like hand washing, social distancing adapted by beneficiaries to avoid contamination in the 5 project villages.

Home visit involved with extreme care and attention that there was no over-crowding, they covered face mask to avoid any contamination.

Mass education program created to sensitise the population.

As it was difficult to control the audience for the above program, RPDS had chosen to confine to only family and individual method of education to inform people about the impending dangers of corona outbreak.
